

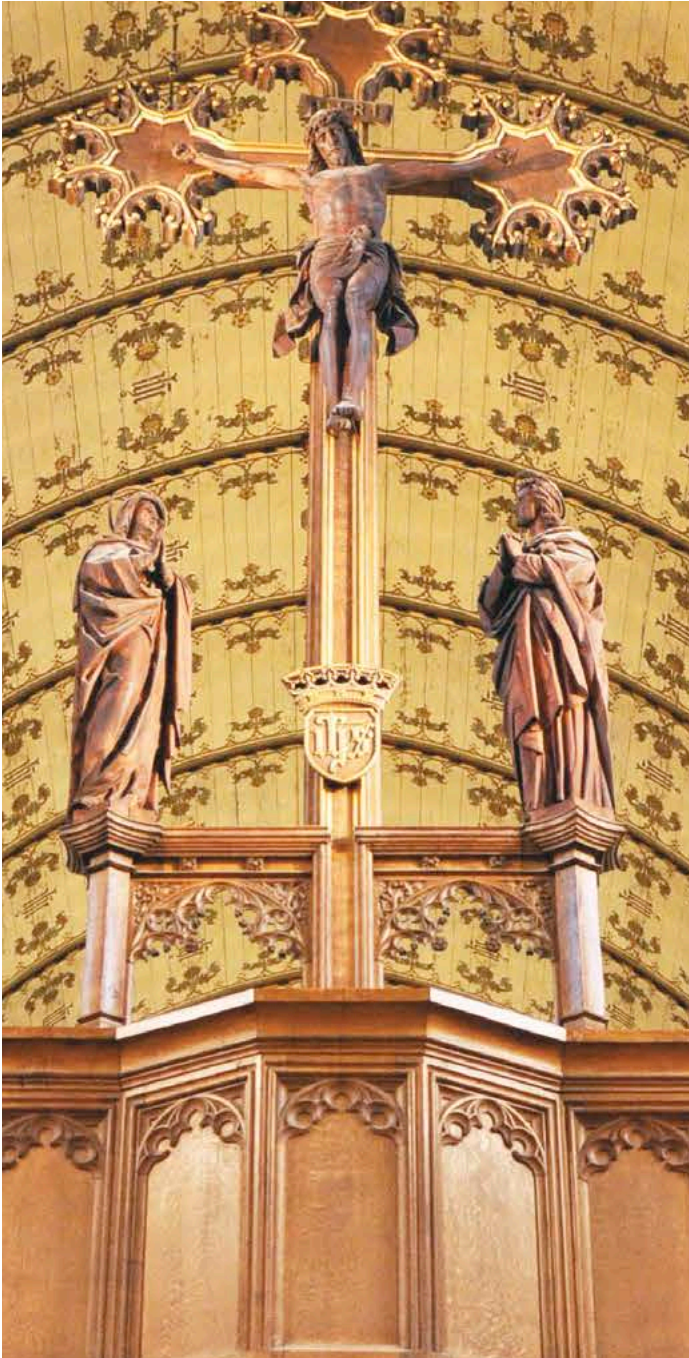

Leaving the College a gift in your Will

Sometimes the support we would like to show an organisation isn't possible in our lifetime.

Many of the College's alumni and friends are doing important vocational work in communities across the country and wider world, however this work is often not well rewarded financially. For many, leaving a gift in a Will can be the most significant opportunity to make a lasting difference.

Leaving the College a gift in your Will is to leave a legacy to support the future work of St Stephen's House.

Why give money in your will?

- For many, it is the most significant opportunity to show support for those organisations we hold dear
- Because St Stephen's House is a registered charity, all legacies to the College are exempt from Inheritance Tax
- Under current UK legislation, an estate that gives at least 10% to charity, receives a 10% discount on the amount of Inheritance Tax due (i.e. 36% rather than 40%)

Types of legacy giving

- Residuary Legacy – a percentage of your estate after other bequests have been met
- Pecuniary Legacy – a specific sum, which could be index-linked
- Specific Legacy – examples include property, art, stocks & shares
- Reversionary Legacy – becomes payable after the death of another
